Thank you to those who attended the Information Meeting held on Monday evening, 17<sup>th</sup> May. For various reasons Narara Valley Baptist Church won't be going ahead with lodging a tender for Niagara Park Shopping Centre.

During the evening there was some discussion concerning the "Consolidated Facilities Document". This document seeks to set out, with the input of a number of ministry leaders, how and what we might be looking to build on 127 Narara Valley Drive or any other suitable site, to serve the church and local community.

The importance of this document cannot be understated; it will form the basis for the briefing of architects, builders, council and many others. Everyone interested needs to have a look the document because it is the opportunity to let me know if you do not agree or have further information which you believe should be added.

Once this document is closed we do not want to be coming back and continually changing it as each change will more than likely increase our costs.

Comment was previously invited from anyone interested but it appears the importance was possibly missed and therefore I agreed to open the document again for comment until the end of June 2010.

The document is available on the Church web site almost 70 pages or you can order a section or the whole document from the church office, an order form is available. We are also endeavouring to provide at least one copy to each Growth Group.
